

# On-TRAC Program Plan

**Guaranteed Admission** Successful completion of the On-TRAC Program guarantees admission to UTSA but does not guarantee admission to a particular college or major. Students who complete the program requirements will be automatically admitted (no application is required). Students who do not successfully complete the On-TRAC requirements must pursue admission to UTSA thru the regular admission process for transfer admission.

**Criteria** Successful On-TRAC students must meet the following criteria.

- I must enroll in and Complete 24 semester credit hours (SCH) of college level coursework at an Alamo College institution, from a prescribed list of course, by the end of the spring term (*at least 15 hours in the fall at Alamo and 9 hours in the spring at Alamo*).
- I must enroll in and Complete 6 semester credit hours (SCH) of college level coursework at UTSA, from a prescribed list of courses, during the spring term.
- I must have a minimum 2.25 Alamo College GPA (cumulative) on the completed 24 SCH and a 2.25 UTSA GPA (cumulative) on the completed 6 SCH.
- I must have met all Texas Success Initiative (TSI) requirements met, either complete or exempt, by completion of the On-TRAC program.
- I must have met my Meningitis Vaccine requirement and submitted proof.

**Note:** Credit earned from AP exams, dual credit courses, CLEP, etc. will not be counted toward the hours needed to complete the On-TRAC requirements. Students who have earned the prescribed courses through AP, dual credit, etc. can take additional courses that are applicable to the UTSA core component area.

**GPA Calculation** A GPA will be calculated at each institution based on the courses taken by the student at that institution. Grades for all transferable courses are to be used in the computation of the GPA at the respective institutions, including the following: Failing grades (F), repeated courses, withdraw Failing (WF), Incomplete, etc. Grades reported as “Incomplete” are computed as Fs until the Incomplete is replaced with a permanent grade.

**Withdrawals** An On-TRAC student who withdraws or drops from his/her UTSA course(s) and drops to zero UTSA SCH will be withdrawn from UTSA for that semester, thus forfeiting all UTSA student privileges (i.e. use of campus facilities, etc.) Unless otherwise prohibited, this student may continue with ONTRAC in the following semester, but will still need to meet the necessary requirements for the program.

**Removal from On-TRAC Program** Students removed from On-TRAC Program for either academic or disciplinary reasons will not be guaranteed admission to UTSA. An On-TRAC student removed from the program will not be permitted continued enrollment at UTSA. An On-TRAC student removed from the program may continue at Alamo Colleges at the discretion of Alamo College officials.

**Upon Successful Completion of On-TRAC Requirements** On-TRAC must meet the following enrollment guidelines:

- a. An On-TRAC student will automatically be admitted to UTSA the following fall semester without submitting another application (no need to reapply).
- b. Alamo Colleges will automatically send students' transcripts to UTSA.
- c. UTSA will automatically send students' transcript to Alamo College (Reverse Transfer) upon successful completion of 66 SCH
- d. An On-TRAC student will become eligible for the Distinguished Transfer Scholarship at UTSA if the minimum requirement for the scholarship is met and funding is available ([future.utsa.edu/scholarships](https://future.utsa.edu/scholarships)).
