### What is the cost?

No tuition is charged to students from sponsoring school districts; \$500 otherwise

If eligible, student may receive free lunch daily and free or reduced bus fares



### Will student receive High School Credit?

-Parent/Guardian must check with school counselor or administrator on how the credit may be applied. Note that the program does not oversee how schools/districts apply this credit to a student's transcript.

-If elected to, students may receive one high school Career and Technical Education credit for each summer of PREP successfully completed.

-Students receive a Completion Certificate with Pass/Fail to provide to school, note that a grade is not released.
