

1. Welcome Center (BRG)

UT San Antonio's Welcome Center brings thousands of visitors to campus each year, offering various campus tours and providing information about the university and the campus.

If arriving by bus, please start at the Convocation Center.



2. Main Building (MB)

The Main Building houses COEHD, Global Initiatives, International Student Services and leadership offices including the President's Office. COEHD offers nationally recognized programs and one of Texas's largest teacher certification programs.

3. John Peace Library (JPL)

The John Peace Library features the campus's largest food court and key student services like the Center for Military Affiliated Students, Fiscal Services and the One Stop Enrollment Center, where future Roadrunners can get help with financial aid and admissions.

4. Sombrilla

The Sombrilla is the heart of UT San Antonio's main campus. Here you can find students enjoying time with friends, studying, eating and enjoying the fresh air. It's also home to the Fountain of Luck! Students touch the fountain wall during finals week for good luck on their exams (or so the legend goes!).

Birds Up!

The origins of the Roadrunner hand sign have become a mixture of myth and mystery, but it's one of the easiest ways for Roadrunners to show their UT San Antonio spirit!



5. Roadrunner Statue

This six-foot-tall, eleven-foot-long, thousand-pound statue features 1,000 handcrafted feathers. Located in the Academic Quad, the statue is a central hub connecting most academic buildings.

6. Student Union (SU)

The Student Union (also called the SU) is the focal point for events, dining, and relaxation. It provides fun activities, helpful resources and plenty of space to relax and study.

7. The Paseo

Modeled after the San Antonio River walk, the Paseo is one of the most iconic outdoor spaces on campus. It's home to various student offices including the Office of Student Activities, Roadrunner Productions and the Student Government Association.

8. Recreation Wellness Center (RWC)

Enjoy several recreational amenities including five multi-purpose courts, a TV/gaming lounge area, racquetball courts, an aquatics center with an outdoor pool, demonstration kitchen, multiple cardio and weight rooms and a 54-foot tall rock climbing wall.

9. Active-Connected Space (BB)

Located in the Business Building, these high-tech, activeconnected spaces feature a tiered structure with moveable tables and chairs and technology to support viewing content.

10. Makerspace (SEB)

Located in the Science and Engineering Building (SEB), this innovative workshop space allows students to engage in hands-on projects and research.
