HOW TO APPLY

- 1** **Apply** online on ApplyTexas or CommonApp
- 2** Pay \$70 **Application Fee** or submit Fee Waiver
- 3** Submit **Self-Reported Academic Record (SRAR)** or HS Transcript (6SEM)
- 4** **Send test scores**
SAT & ACT not required but considered
recommended for some scholarships & majors
- 5** **Submit additional docs** based on your myUTSA Admissions portal checklist
- 6** **Check your admissions status** and/or attend an info session!

APP FEE WAIVER

How to Apply

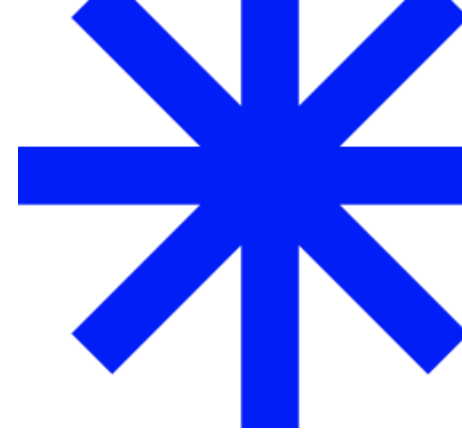
Step 1: Indicate a fee waiver request on Common App. Skip to Step 2 if applying on ApplyTexas.

- Eligible freshman applicants must demonstrate financial need
- International students and transfer students are not eligible for fee waiver







Step 2: Submit UTSA recommended supporting documentation

Supporting Document

- Submit ACT, SAT, or NACAC fee waiver form
- High School counselor requests for fee waiver submitted via Common Application
- Pell Grant eligible
- Ward of the State or orphan
- Family receives public assistance
- IRS transcript reflecting the total family income is at or below the federal economic index for free/reduced lunch eligibility requirements.
- Live in federally subsidized public housing, foster home or homeless



AFTER YOU APPLY

-  Get a **myUTSA ID** via email
-  Login to our **myUTSA Admissions** portal
-  Check your status and complete your **Admission Checklist**
-  Apply for scholarship on the **UTSA Scholarship HUB**
-  Once available, submit your **FAFSA/TASFA** to UTSA
-  Once admitted, go back to the myUTSA Admissions portal for **Rowdy Ready Checklist**

MYUTSA ADMISSIONS PORTAL

Once your students submit their application they will receive an email to claim their myUTSA ID, which will be used to access the myUTSA Admissions Portal. They can check their admission status, missing requirements, pay application fee and more



TEXAS RESIDENCY

- 1 Must be a citizen, national or a permanent resident of the United States
- 2 Submit documentation showing residence and gainful employment within the state of Texas for 12 consecutive months

- 3 Complete UTSA Residency Application
- 4 Complete Residency Questionnaire

→ **PLEASE NOTE:** Requirements may differ for individual student situations and may be handled on a case-by-case basis

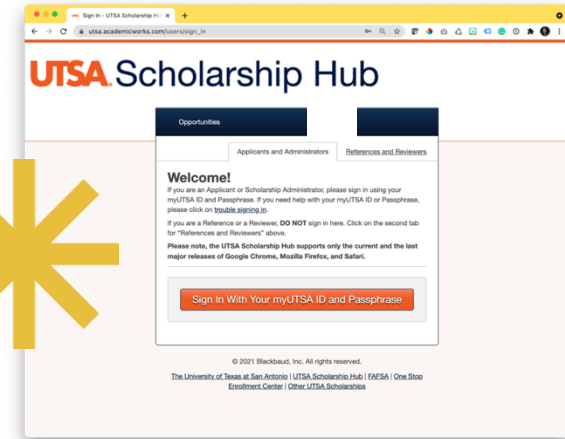
Distinguished Presidential Scholarship (DPS)

- Fall freshman applicants
- Automatic Consideration (must be admitted by January 15)
- Value up to \$20,000 for up to four years if renewal eligibility is maintained
- Invitation to UTSA Honors College

SCHOLARSHIP YOU APPLY FOR

UTSA Scholarship HUB

- Access after you apply to UTSA
- Fill out the **Hub's General Scholarship Application** to be considered for pool of scholarships
- Other Scholarships students are eligible for also available on the Hub, deadlines will vary
- **Apply by January 15**

Texas Application for State Financial Aid

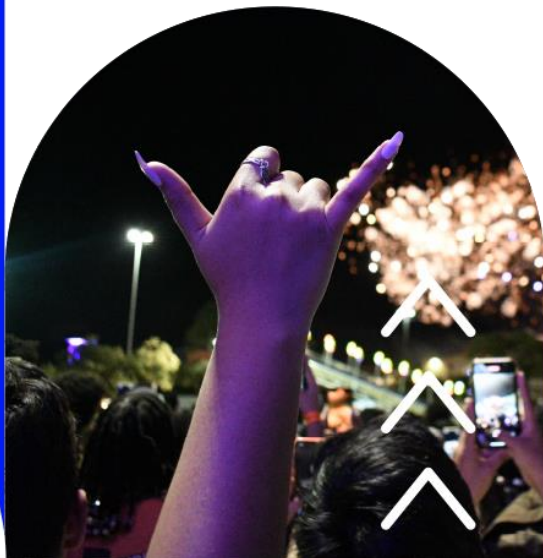
- Graduated from public or private high school
 - Resided in TX state for at least 3 years as of the date the person graduated from high school or received GED
 - Has lived in Texas the 12 months prior to enrollment Student
 - Must be coded “HB 1403” by Admission’s Office
 - Not a US Citizen or Permanent Resident
 - Submit a signed affidavit indicating intent to apply for permanent residency
 - Upload all documents using the UTSA Document Uploader
 - **Available: December 1**

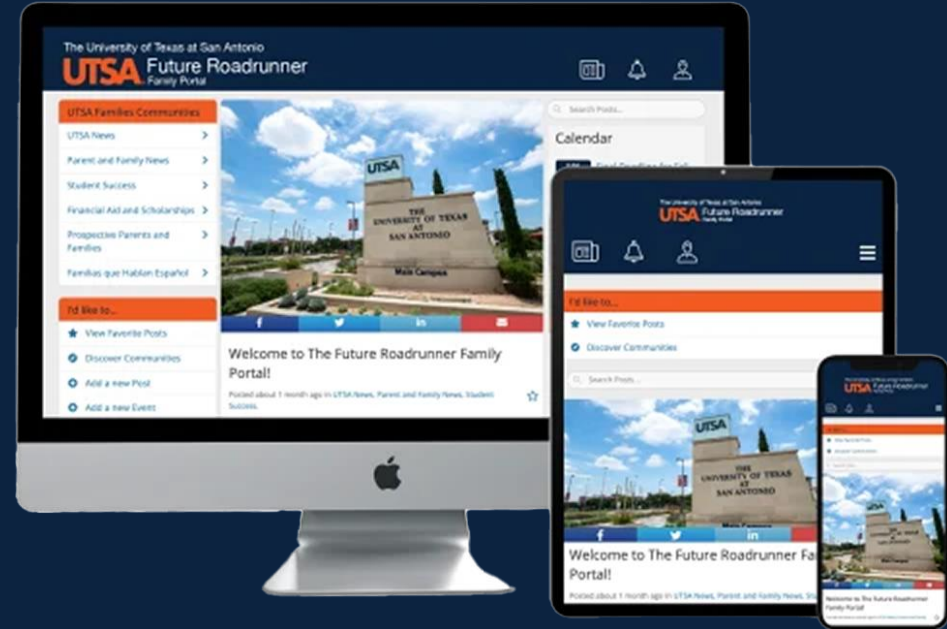


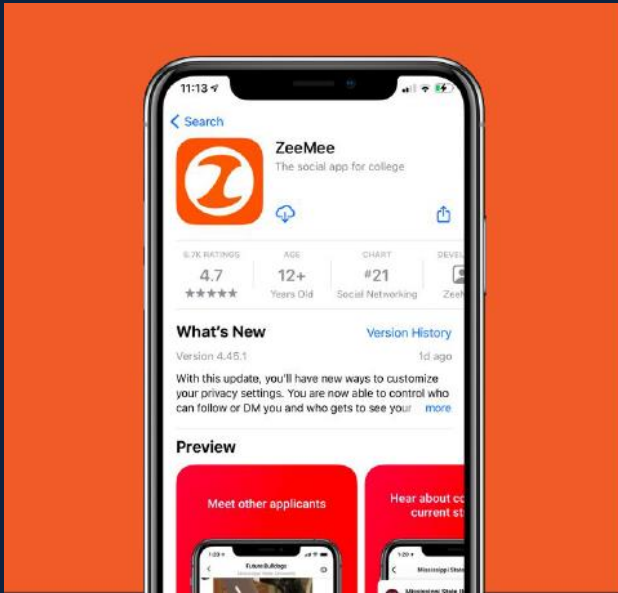

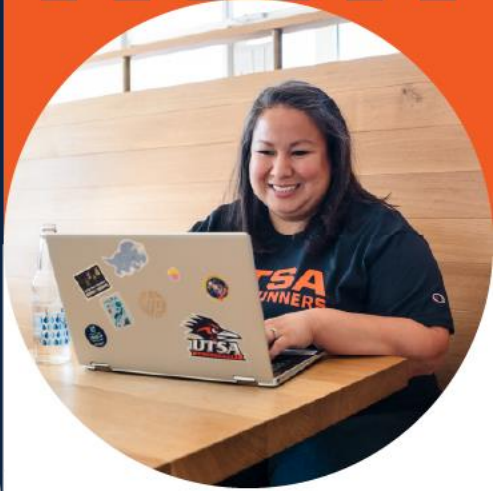
